ALA Library Capacity Building Grants Review Scoring System and Rating Guide (2024)

Application Criteria

Grant guidelines state 'applications will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- The budget cuts and impact on library to provide services to the community.
- Identification of target audience(s) and their needs.
- Proposed use of grant funds to serve target audiences.
- Expected outcomes and impacts and measurements.
- Budget and alignment of requested items/elements to proposed activities.

Scoring System and Rating Guide

These areas will be scored as Weak, Moderate, or Strong for each section being rated/scored.

Weak = 1

Average = 2

Strong = 3

Question Areas for Review

1. Current budget and staffing	.5
2. Library and current (not current) service	.5
3. Target audience and needs	1.0
4. Use of grant funds to support target	1.5
5. Anticipated outcomes and impacts	1.5
6. Budget and alignment	1.0
