Whereas we are opposed to the Church amendment which would give Congress the power to intervene militarily in foreign countries.

Therefore, we, the African American Association of the ALA, voted to

urge the United States Congress to pass the Cooper-Church amendment giving Congress the power to intervene militarily in foreign countries.

Congress was responsible to direct action.
