Whereas, On April 22, 1990 people in the United States celebrated the twentieth anniversary of Earth Day, and

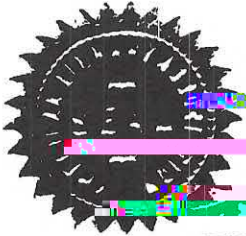
Whereas, Libraries and librarians have learned a great deal of information on the environment, and

Whereas, Many librarians have active recycling, educational and other programs supportive of civic environmental groups and research efforts, and

Whereas, These efforts have not yet become a general policy of the American Library Association urging upon all librarians, therefore be it

Resolved, That the American Library Association encourage libraries to celebrate Earth Day as a way to focus public attention on environmental issues further

Resolved, That the American Library Association encourage libraries to cooperate with other organizations to collect and provide information on the condition of the air, ground, water and living organisms from all available sources
