



RESOLUTION ON PRINCIPLES FOR THE NATIONAL INFORMATION INFRASTRUCTURE

- WHEREAS,** A set of principles for the development of the National Information Infrastructure was developed by representatives of ALA and several other library and information associations at a policy forum in September 1993; and
- WHEREAS,** These principles, as a working draft, have provided a basis for discussion in the library community and have been adopted as a policy statement;
- WHEREAS,** These principles have been further elaborated within the framework of ALA policy, and will be further discussed at the 1994 Annual Conference in Miami; and
- WHEREAS,** These principles will serve as a basis for further development and evolution by working groups in a rapidly changing technological and policy environment;
- RESOLVED,** That the American Library Association support the principles of the National Information Infrastructure as published on February 8-10, 1993, telecommunications and information policy, and that the Association will support the development of the National Information Infrastructure with appropriate funding, subject to the availability of funds.
